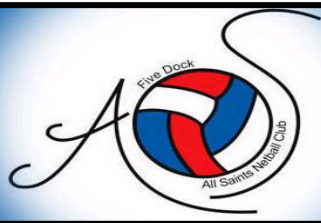

Background Information regarding IWSNA Competition:

Players that compete in Under 12's competition, and over, are to umpire the FDAS matches at Cintra during the Winter Competition Season. The Club will provide an experienced umpire [called a Runner] to assist the "umpires in training" during these matches. Your team manager will work out your umpire roster, and from past experience the girls would umpire two or three times throughout the season.

Once the draw is known it will be emailed to each Team Manager. The Manager/s (from the U12's & up) are then to arrange their team's umpire roster. If we fail to provide umpires our Club's teams will be penalized: - such as loss of competition points to the FDAS playing team, as well as a fine for failing to provide an umpire (these fines are paid by the team failing to provide an umpire, not the Club).
