How to Avoid Fines & Penalties

(Information below is taken from the IWSNA "By-Laws" doc found on the IWNSA website, not FDAS)

1. Umpiring

Any FDAS Junior team and FDAS Senior team failing to fulfill their rostered umpiring duties will be fined \$50.00 per umpire and the playing FDAS team will lose 2 points.

2. Forfeits

Teams involved in a forfeit are still required to provide umpires for that day. Each team is allowed one (1) notified forfeit without incurring a fine. Thereafter teams will incur a \$25.00 fine for each subsequent game forfeited. If a team forfeits the last week of competition the team will be liable for a \$50.00 fine.

3. Score Sheets

All players must be sighted against their photo card by the opposing team **PRIOR** to the game starting., place a "tick" against the players name on the score sheet card – signatures are not required (leave that section blank).

If applicable, complete the section for players playing up when a player from another FDAS team plays in your team, include their full name, team, and age division they are from and make sure their photo has been sighted and a tick is placed against their name.

At the end of the game write the total score in the appropriate box for each team on the score card. The Scorers, Umpires and Captains must sign the score sheet **BEFORE** it is returned to the Admin block. The score sheet cards are to be returned **PROMPTLY** by the winning team to the Admin Block Building – don't leave it in your team bag or take it home.
