#### COACH / PLAYER DEVELOPMENT OFFICER

#### **Attention FDAS Coaches:**

Gentle reminder to all our coaches that you are not permitted to pace/run up and down the sideline or goal line during a match, you are not permitted to coach from the baseline. This is not a Club rule, this is a Netball Australia rule which can be found in the "Official Rules of Netball (2007)" booklet (Rule 3.4.2: Team Official and bench players may not move up and down the Side Lines or along the Goal Lines outside the Court during the play).

I encourage all coaches and managers to read the rule book.

Below is a recap from the Coaches/Managers meeting that was held earlier in the year:

#### COACHING - CURRENT RULES AS AT 2010 / 2011

Team Officials & Bench Players may coach while play is in progress BUT they must remain seated or stand at their Team Bench.

Coaching is also allowed during stoppages. Team Officials may approach the players AT THE SIDE LINE (not on court). Bench players may also approach the side line IF coaching occurs. Team Officials may also approach the players AT THE SIDE LINE for the purpose of providing rehydration.

#### STOPPAGES - CURRENT RULES AS AT 2010 / 2011

Coaching is permitted during any stoppage by any Team Official who may approach the players AT THE SIDE LINE (not on court). Bench players may also approach the side line IF coaching occurs. Any Team Official may approach the players AT THE SIDE LINE for the purpose of providing rehydration.

Play may be stopped for injury or illness by an on court player. The umpire will stop play, not the parents. The umpire will blow the whistle to stop play, someone should be taking time.

1st stoppage in each quarter (or half) is up to 2 minutes from when time is "held"

Primary Care personnel is permitted to enter the court, no other Team Official from the bench is permitted on court – please let the other team and umpire know that the person entering the court is the team's primary carer.

Player has 30 seconds to leave the court; treatment is to occur off court (not on the court). As always common sense is to be used if the injury is serious and medical attention is needed.

Above rules have been modified slightly by IFNA/Netball Australia for the 2012 season – **BUT** we are waiting IWNSA's decision if they are to implement the changes. FDAS will inform the coaches if changes have been made.
