Secretary's Report

Dear Parents and Spectators

With the start of the Season upon us, we take this timely opportunity to remind all parents and spectators to show respect and common decency when watching netball. Applaud good play by your team and the opposing team. Respect the decision of the coach or umpire/umpire in training. They are doing the best job possible and without their support and valued contribution we would not be able to field the teams to participate in netball. The Association adopts an 'umpire your own games' approach therefore we are to supply umpires and umpires in training. The umpires in training wear a yellow fluorescent vest which says 'In Training'. It is a clearly visible statement that the umpire is in training and is being guided in this skill. Umpiring can be daunting for the most experienced, let alone for an umpire in training who is doing the best they can – bear in mind that they will be nervous and might even make an incorrect call, be sympathetic and tolerate – show maturity.

Spectators please do not call out to the team or the umpires. Do not approach the team, umpire or umpire in training. The coach and manager are the only persons authorized to *speak* to the players and umpires.

Our club and the Association apply the Netball New South Wales, Spectator Code of Conduct. Spectators must not question, shout abuse or intimidate any player, umpire or umpire in training. We and the Association strictly apply the **Code of Conduct for the protection of children** and adopt a **zero tolerance** to any person who abuses a player, umpire or umpire in training. The Code is on our Club website and set out below.

Netball NSW Spectator Code of Behaviour

In addition to Netball NSW's General Code of Behaviour, you must meet the following requirements with regard to your conduct during any activity held by or under the auspices of Netball NSW or a District/League Association, in your role as a spectator.

- 1. Remember that young people participate in sport for their enjoyment and benefit, not yours.
- 2. Applaud good performance and efforts by all individuals and teams. When watching a game congratulate all participants on their performance regardless of the game's outcome.
- 3. Respect the decisions of umpires and coaches.
- 4. Never ridicule or scold a young player for making a mistake. Positive comments are motivational.
- 5. Condemn the use of violence in any form, be it by coaches, players, umpires, administrators or other parents/quardians.
- 6. Show respect for your team's coach, the umpire and opponents. Without them there would be no game.
- 7. Encourage players to play according to the rules and official decisions, and develop your own knowledge of the rules.
- 8. Demonstrate appropriate social behaviour by refraining from using foul language and harassing administrators, coaches, players or umpires.
- 9. Support the use of age appropriate development activities and modified rules.
- 10. Do not interfere with the progress and/or conduct of a game.

As parents and friends we ask that you show respect for the kids. If you are not able to be respectful and mature, you will be removed from the Park.

Umpiring Corner



Well done to all our 12's & 13's that attended the **FDAS** umpire clinic – we hope you enjoyed yourselves



By now all the coaches and managers would have received notification of their team's grade and playing times. The fixture is now available to view/download from the IWSNA website in the "Competitions" menu www.innerwest.netball.asn.au

Last year we had 31 teams playing, this year we have a thumping 37 teams! 28 of those 37 teams are playing between 8:30am to 10:30am which means the club has a very heavy demand for umpires and runners during these time slots. Under the IWSNA rules failure to supply an umpire will incur a fine of \$50 per umpire, payable by the team, not FDAS, to IWNSA and loss of two (2) competition points from the team that is playing the match. It's very important to make sure umpire/s attend to umpire – dressed in club uniform, turn up 15 minutes before the game and sign the umpire sheet at the Cintra Park Administration building – failure to turn up may lead to the playing team to lose **their** competition points

We have over the last few days notified the Manager/s (from the 12's & up) of the games they are to umpire; in the meantime managers please organize your team's umpire roster. We understand that some players may not be able to umpire due to study/work commitments or just not interested and that's fine **but** if we do not have umpires our team may not be permitted to play; and for our new umpires (the 12's) we need runners so if you would like to help just as a runner and not umpire we would love to hear from you too J

Note to our Coaches/Managers for the 8y's team: you are to umpire your team's game for one half and then the opposing team's coach/manager is to umpire the next half. The umpire (coach or manager) is permitted to enter the court to help direct play for both teams. Each team is provided with a score sheet and the player's rotation must be recorded for each game. No goals are recorded on the score sheet. The modified rules for 8ys and 9ys can be found on our website.
