Coaching Courses

The Beginning Coaching General Principles Online Course - Compulsory for all coaches who have not yet completed. Cost: Free

The Australian Sports Commission (ASC) course assists coaches to learn the basic skills of coaching, particularly those coaches working with children. Completed online in your own time & takes approx. 6 hours to complete. Beginners Coaching Course – Compulsory for new coaches & those who have not attended previously

For new/inexperienced coaches focusing on ages 8-12. Make up a training session, warm up, footwork, passing. Introduction to shooting and defence techniques.

Dare to Develop a Diamond – Recommended for all coaches of teams 11-13 years.

Umpiring Corner



Note to our 2012 Under 12 teams:

It is compulsory for the Club to provide umpires for competition games, this is an IWSNA requirement. Players in the Under 12's and over competitions are to umpire the FDAS matches; the Club will provide Runner's to assist the "umpires in training" during these matches.

Once grades and playing times are known the Manager is required to arrange their team's umpire roster. Failure to supply an umpire will incur a **penalty fee** from IWSNA and is paid by the FDAS team (not the Club) supplying the umpire, plus loss of competition points from the FDAS team playing. Please read the rule book, and then *click* on club's website for details regarding the online umpire's course.
