Secretary's Report

IMPORTANT - PLEASE READ

CODE OF CONDUCT REMINDER

There have been a few incidents in this first half of the season, and now that we have reached the midway point of the season it is a timely opportunity to remind all members of some key points in our Code Of Conduct policies. The Club, as well as the Association, will take firm action against any unacceptable behavior by players, coaches, umpires, parents and spectators.

Show respect for all coaches and club officials. Remember that all positions are unpaid and the Club would not exist without our volunteers. Abuse or intimidation will not be tolerated from players, parents or spectators. Parents are expected to model the behavior we want of our players. If you disagree with an umpire or coach raise the issue through the appropriate channels rather than question their judgment and honesty in public.

Never ridicule or abuse any player, particularly for making a mistake or losing a game. or make an inappropriate comment about a fellow volunteer, coach, umpire, official, athlete. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all people involved in netball, regardless of gender, marital status, race, colour, disability, sexuality, age, occupation, religion or political opinion

Show respect for your team's coach, the umpire and opponents. Without them there would be no game.

Model appropriate behavior. Applaud good plays by all teams and encourage all players. Children learn best from examples and remember that children are involved in the sport for their enjoyment, not yours.

Do not interfere with the progress and/or conduct of a game.

Thank you to 23 of our coaches who completed the FDAS Coaching Survey last month. The information we received from the survey results will assist us with planning courses for 2014 and has provided us with feedback about which courses you found the most useful.

We had 20 of our players attend the Susan Pratley Goal Shooting clinic a couple of weeks ago. It was very exciting to have Susan (the NSW Swifts shooter and Australian Diamonds player) provide personal instruction to the girls. We hope you have all been working on your technique and also practising throughout the week. I recall Susan mentioning that she shoots about 200 goals most days of the week!

There were about 5 teams who expressed interest in attending carnivals at other associations. There were a couple of teams to confirm which carnival they were interested in attending. The cutoff date for registering at some of these carnivals is 28 June, therefore we do need confirmation ASAP.



Umpiring Corner



IMPORTANT PLEASE READ

As the competition has just past the midway point and teams are vying for the top spots in their division the club would like to remind all members of some of the Code of Conduct policies regarding our umpires and runners.

Our umpires and runners are young and need our encouragement and support, not huffing and puffing or derogative remarks from the sideline by the spectators which only serves to destroy any confidence these girls have and go home in tears which also upsets their parents – if we did not have our umpires your daughter's team would not be able to play - the more our girls umpire (or run) the better they become at their jobs , no-one is perfect in life, particularly when they first pick up a whistle.

Also we wish to clarify with you the role of a "runner", the runners is not permitted to umpire the game and does not have a whistle on them; they are only to run with the umpires giving guidance and support. The actual game is officiated by the umpire but at the end of each quarter the runners (who are a badged umpire) advise and guide the "umpires in training". It is then up to the 'umpire in training" to put in practice the advice and recommendations given to them by their runner.

If there is a problem please come and see one of the Umpire Committee members who are down at Cintra Park from the first game of the day.

A reminder to all that:

You must treat all umpires in accordance with the FDAS/NNSW Code of Conduct policy.

Umpiring is often a tough job and our umpires and runners are often young and apprehensive but are always trying to do their hest.

Please remember that any comments on the sidelines are often heard by the umpires (and runners) and this does not help with their confidence; and reflects poorly upon that spectator.

Spectators must not approach or communicate in any way with the umpire directly (only the team captain can do this, and only during one of the quarter time breaks)
